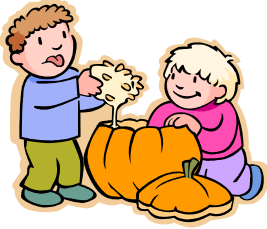


## Second Grade Newsletter

Math: We will continue to work on “place value” up to 999. We will also compare and order numbers, and our “Problem Solving Workshop Strategy,” will be to learn to use logical reasoning to solve word problems. We will also continue to review vocabulary, fact families, and number of the day.

Reading/Language: This week we will be reading several different Cinderella stories. Students will use the 3 way venn diagram to compare and contrast the stories. In English, we will continue to learn about proper nouns and how to use them in our writing. We will also learn about pronouns. Our spelling words this week are words with the “cl” and “cr” blends.

Writer’s Workshop: We will continue to expand stories by answering the “**who, what, where, why, when and how**” questions. Students will start conferencing with the teacher, and sharing their stories with other students the class.
