Dear Cable Families,

The San Antonio Metropolitan Health District has notified Northside ISD that the district has five probable cases of the H1N1 influenza virus, also known as swine flu, including one probable case at Cable.

Upon notification late in the day Thursday, the district promptly dispatched additional custodial staff to aggressively clean and sanitize the school. As an added measure, all air conditioning filters were also replaced Thursday evening.

In accordance with Metro Health and Centers for Disease Control guidelines, Cable will remain open. Classes, extracurricular activities and events will continue as scheduled unless otherwise advised by Metro Health and the CDC.
