

Some Geocaching Educational Ideas

- 01 Track the adventures of a class travel bug.
- 02 Have a GPS scavenger hunt during a field trip
- 03 Use cache visit logs for proofreading/editing
- 04 Have students solve the puzzles on mystery/puzzle caches
- 05 Use a local map and have students mark new cache listings
- 06 Research famous people/historical figures, and then send a bug to their birthplace.
- 07 Compare the average speed of bus, car, bike and walking for the same trip.
- 08 Survey an area and make a map by recording your distance along a bearing and transferring to graph paper.
- 09 Create GPS trails of your local area with an accompanying brochure.
- 10 Ask students to find locationless caches for extra credit.
- 11 Let your class design and hide a cache as a class project.
- 12 Incorporate the CITO philosophy to your Earth Day or ecology units.
