

Adobe Audition Project – Audio Play

Spend some time listening old radio plays (examples located on the CLASS FILES folder on the server). As a group, write and record an original audio play that includes voice recordings, sound effects, and original music.

Minimum Requirements

- Original Script
 - Script must be typed and double spaced (use template on CLASS FILES folder)
 - All members must have a role but limit script to four characters (not including narrator)
- Sound Effects
 - Must have at least 3 different sound effects
 - Sound effects must be noted in script
- Original Music
 - Use loops to create original purposeful music
- Final Product
 - Minimum of 3 minutes and maximum of 5 minutes
 - Save as an **mp3** on the server in the appropriate period folder.

Criteria

The most important criteria for this assignment is the realism of the audio. The recording should be convincing. Pay attention to details when combining the audios.

Effort is likely to have an indirect effect on your grade. Recording your voices and pasting it on some music, for instance, might be an easy way to satisfy the minimum requirements of the project, but such a project would not demonstrate exceptional use of the tools available. More credit will be given to projects that demonstrate a sophisticated understanding of the tools. Making "improvements" to your audio will also help your grade. Remove unwanted noise in the recording.

A project that fulfills only the minimal requirements will receive an average grade. If the work goes beyond the minimal requirements, is well composed and neat, then the work will receive a higher grade.
