

The Fisher Reading Incentive Program (Pre-Kindergarten -2nd)

Purpose:

For all students in grades Pre-Kindergarten through Second grade, the purpose of the Fisher Reading Incentive Program is to encourage reading outside of school. Students can be read to or can read books independently. If the child is to read the book, the books should be on the student's reading level and/or just above in order to challenge him/her.

Objective of the Program:

Students in Pre-Kinder, Kinder and 1st grade will read 10 books for every level. Students in 2nd grade will read 10 books or chapters for every level. Students and/or parents will fill out the Fisher Elementary Reading Log each time a child reads. Parents/Guardians will sign and verify that their child has read the indicated amount. Once a sheet is completely filled up, the student will return the Reading Log sheet to their classroom teacher. The teacher will then give the student a ribbon on the level they have worked to achieve. The student will then begin reading the books for the next level.

Goal:

Pre-Kindergarten-First Grade:

(By end of December- Level 5-Starfish which equals 50 books)

(By end of the year-Level 10- Marlin which equals 100 books)

Second Grade:

(By end of December- Level 5-Starfish which equals 50 books/chapters)

(By end of the year-Level 10- Marlin which equals 100 books/chapters)

There will be an end of year celebration for all of the students who got to a level 10-Marlin!
