Health Careers High School will be offering free tutoring for any interested student. There will be at least one certified teacher and several NHS “Tutors” helping students with homework. The number of students in attendance will determine how much individual assistance will be available. Every effort will be made to offer as much individual help as possible. We will be having these sessions in our library to facilitate the use of computers for research and projects. Interested students will be instructed to sign up during the week prior to the Saturday session, however, drop-ins are welcomed as well. As the program grows more teachers may be included. Students must bring all materials with them, as they will not be allowed into the main building during this time. This time is provided as a courtesy for students. Any student not using the time productively or who engages in activities that compromise the academic environment may be asked to leave and could forfeit the opportunity to attend future tutoring sessions.

Rules for Saturday Tutoring

1. Bring all necessary materials with you. You will not be allowed to go into the main building to get things out of your locker or out of a classroom. You'll have to plan ahead.
2. The number of students in attendance will determine how much individual assistance will be available. Every effort will be made to offer as much individual help as possible.
3. Students may utilize the tutoring center for any amount of time between the hours of 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m., but once students leave they will not be allowed to re-enter during the tutoring session.
4. All school district rules and regulations will be in effect. (Dress, code of conduct, etc.)
5. A quiet environment conducive to learning must be maintained throughout the entire tutoring session. Disruptive or unruly behavior or actions will not be tolerated. Student offenders will be asked to leave and will be referred to an administrator for disciplinary actions.
6. Students should be picked up promptly at 12:30 p.m. After this time supervision is limited. For students' safety, those students not picked up in a timely fashion may not be allowed to attend future sessions. We appreciate your help in advance with this request.
