During the second week of May, the Texas Education Agency released the results of the 2007 TAKS Test. We are pleased to share those scores with you. In the areas shaded gray below, you will find the percentage rates of Health Careers students who met the passing standard on each test taken per grade level for 2007 and a comparison to the last two years. Because we work toward all students achieving at a higher standard than just the minimum, we also focus on the number of students whose scores meet the Commended status as deemed by the TEA.
