

## MEDICATION POLICY

1. Antibiotics and other short-term medications may be administered at school upon written request from a parent or guardian. Medication must be brought to school in the **original prescription labeled** bottle. Good for **two weeks** only.
2. Long-term medications may be given only if a special medication form is completed by the attending physician and the medication brought in a properly labeled prescription bottle. Must have a current special medication form filled out for each school year. Parent/Guardian must fill out the bottom portion of the form.
3. All medications must be taken to the school clinic by an adult and will be dispensed from the clinic. **Only empty bottles will be sent home with the student.**
4. RN's in Texas may accept orders only from those physicians who are legally authorized to practice in this state.
5. Medication from **Military** physician's may be administered until the parent/guardian is able to have child seen by a new physician at a San Antonio military facility. Be sure medication is **NOT** outdated.
