

6th grade required supply list

Science:

- binder** with up to 5 dividers (# of dividers depends on teacher)
- blue or black pen
- pencil
- highlighter (any color)
- colored pencils
- notebook paper
- students will need one rectangular box of Kleenex, 160 count or larger, for a project (keep at home until needed)

** -binder may be shared with other subjects

Social Studies:

- binder with up to five dividers (# of dividers depends on teacher)
- one or two 70 count spirals (one or two to be determined by teacher)
- colored pencils
- highlighter (any color)
- pen
- notebook paper

** -binder may be shared with other subjects

English:

- one Composition Notebook (any color), 100 sheets with **no wire** holding the notebook together
- markers—8 different colors
- glue
- one highlighter
- blue or black pens (no pencils)
- scissors
- notebook paper
- three ring binder with one divider (may be shared with other subjects)
- colored pencils
- one folder with pockets (any color)

Recommended but not required: one supply pouch with holes

Math:

- Pencils (mechanical preferred)
- dividers (3-4 depending on teacher)
- 1 or 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch binder (they would prefer one binder for math but it can be shared with another subject)
- ruler (with inches and cm)
- red pen
- notebook paper

Reading:

- Binder (may be shared with other subjects)
 - Divider for reading section
 - notebook paper
 - pencils
 - red pen
 - blue or black pens
 - map pencils
 - scissors
 - 1 pocket folder with brads
