MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- High School Diploma or GED
 - Completion of a college level interpreter training program and BEI or RID Certification as an Interpreter for the Deaf
 - Must have satisfactory outcome of fingerprinting check prior to starting employment. Non-refundable fee paid by employee.
- *** Selected applicants may be required to demonstrate skills by completing job simulations.

SPECIAL KNOWLEDGE/SKILLS/ABILITIES

- Knowledge and understanding of the principal of ethical behavior set by the National Registry of Interpreters for the Deaf
- Skill in interpreting and transliterating proficiently in American Sign Language and Signed English
- Ability to communicate effectively, both verbally and in writing
- Ability to consistently demonstrate excellent sign language methods and techniques
- Effective interpersonal skills with students and adults
- Ability to follow verbal and written instructions

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

1. Facilitate communication between students who are deaf and hard of hearing with others within the educational environment.
2. Interpret/transliterate for students with an auditory impairment in the following areas:
 - Mainstream classes
 - School activities during normal school day (field trips, assemblies, conferences, athletic competition, etc.)
 - After school activities, upon request of the Lead Interpreter or designee including PTA, open house, and class programs.
3. Tutor AI students under the direct supervision of the teacher.
4. Teach basic sign language classes on assigned campus.
5. Interpret/transliterate for other district assignments (such as, personnel who are deaf, and/or parents of students who are deaf) upon request from the Lead Interpreter or designee.
6. Perform other duties as assigned.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS/WORKING CONDITIONS

Lifts 5–10 pounds frequently, 10–50 pounds occasionally. Maintain emotional control under stress. Moderate walking, standing, sitting, stooping, kneeling, bending, twisting. Work indoors and outdoors in varying climate conditions. May be required to work more than 40 hours during the work week.
