JOB DESCRIPTION

The teacher in the GT/Enrichment Program works in an instructional setting with students who have been identified as gifted and talented using district established criteria. The teacher acts as a facilitator with students and provides them with appropriate learning activities and experiences designed to help GT students fulfill their potential for intellectual, emotional, and social growth. The GT/Enrichment teacher serves on the Campus Selection Committee and coordinates GT screening and assessment at the campus level. Duties also include classroom and school wide enrichment.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Provide services for students identified to participate in the Gifted and Talented Program.
2. Evaluate the strength and weaknesses of the students in the Gifted and Talented Program.
3. Serve as a member of the Campus Selection Committee to help make program decisions for students screened for the Gifted and Talented Program.
4. Participate in the development of program curriculum.
5. Attend professional development appropriate for the position.
6. Assist in providing school-wide enrichment services.
7. Work closely with parents and campus staff to assist high ability students with academic and affective needs.
8. Lead professional development sessions for teachers and administration at the campus and District levels.
9. Work closely with the G/T Testing Center to provide successful ongoing screening of students for possible participation in the Gifted and Talented Program.
10. Work closely and cohesively with other GT Personnel.
11. Order materials and supplies for program needs.
12. Evaluate the effectiveness of the GT/Enrichment Program.
13. Meet with district gifted and talented department personnel on a regular basis.
14. Perform other duties as assigned.
