- **\$35.00 non-refundable application fee** (current and past W.B.U. students are exempt)
- **Statement describing your purpose and objectives in pursuing graduate study at W.B.U.**
- **Transcript(s)** from ALL college-level work
- **Official scores** from the Graduate Record Examination (**G.R.E**), the Graduate Management Admission Test (**G.M.A.T.**), or the **Miller Analogies Test**
- **Official scores** from the **TASP**
- **Official scores** from the **TEsES**

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

- Official transcripts must be evaluated by a credentials evaluation agency
- A score of 500 or more on the official Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) exam
- An affidavit of support
- A copy of documentation of visa status

The Master of Education degree is designed to enhance the preparation and leadership of individuals within the education profession and those entering teaching. The focus of the Master of Education is curriculum and instruction. Students engage in academic and professional studies focused on teaching and leadership. The degree is a minimum of thirty-six semester credit hour program with a professional emphasis. The objectives of the degree are:

1. To enhance the knowledge base and skills necessary for effective teaching and leadership.
2. To integrate theory with practice to enrich the quality of instruction and teaching.
3. To develop skills for analyzing decision-making and action based on a thoughtful analysis of pertinent data.

M.Ed. DEGREE REQUIREMENTS:

1. **36 semester hours** of approved graduate credit
2. **24 semester hours** of graduate courses taken **with W.B.U.**
3. **Cumulative G.P.A. of 3.00** or higher for all graduate courses at W.B.U.
4. **No grade less than C**, and **no more than 9** semester hours with grades of C
5. No transfer grade **less than B**
6. Successfully completed **Comprehensive Exam** over degree program
7. Completed within **seven years**

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS DEGREE-SEEKING STUDENTS:

A student who holds a Bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited institution and meets ONE of the following conditions is eligible for admission to the M.Ed. program:

1. A total Verbal plus Quantitative **G.R.E. score** of **850** or higher
2. A total of **16** or more **Graduate Entry Points** computed by the following formula: **(G.R.E. Verbal/100)+(G.R.E./ Quantitative/100)+(*G.P.A. x3) =G.E.Points.**
3. A total of **16** or more **Graduate Entry Points** computed by the following formula: **(G.M.A.T./60)+(*G.P.A. x3.00) = G.E.Points**
4. A score of **45** or more on the **Miller Analogies Test** and have a ***G.P.A. of 3.00** or more.
4. An earned **graduate degree** from a regionally accredited university.
***G.P.A. calculated from the last 60 semester hrs completed at the time of application.**

ADDITIONAL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR MIDDLE SCHOOL AND HIGH SCHOOL CERTIFICATION

Students must successfully pass the **TASP** and **TEsES** in the subject field before being admitted into the post baccalaureate program.

CERTIFICATION

All students pursuing initial certification must have passing **TASP** scores with a **reading score of 260 or better** prior to course enrollment. The certification program requires a **2.7 overall G.P.A.** on the undergraduate work.
