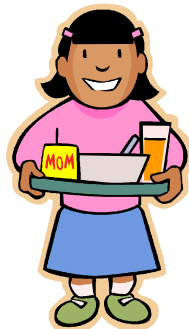


More Anson Jones Information

What are the expectations of the Cafeteria?

Breakfast is available from 7:30-8:15. Students are to report directly to the cafeteria if they want to eat breakfast. All students are provided a 30 minute lunch period. Students are walked to the cafeteria by their teachers so that classes are not disrupted. All classes will be assigned to a table. This is so teachers can pick up their class and escort them back to class. Students who are eligible for free or reduced meals must fill out an application. Free/reduced meals will not be provided until the application has been approved through NISD Child Nutrition Department. Parents can set up a meal account and replenish the funds as needed. Per NISD policy, students are not allowed to charge their meals. If a student's account does not have enough funds to purchase a meal, the student will not be permitted to eat that day. Parents can monitor their children's lunch account through the online Parent Connection. Students may also bring their own lunches. Please call 397-2135 if you have any questions about our meals.

Students will have 7 classes . 6th graders will take Reading, English, Math , Science, P.E. and an Elective. 7th and 8th graders will have English, Math, Science, P.E.,and an elective. Students who need additional reading support in 7th or 8th grade will have a reading class in lieu of a P.E. or elective. Students take district benchmark tests to measure their progress. When a student shows signs of struggling with academic skills, the student will receive additional support through tutorials and intervention classes. Where do I go when I get on campus?

7:30-7:55– Students report to the Cafeteria

7:55-8:25– 6th grade– Auxiliary Gym

7th grade– Science Hallway

8th grade– Competition Gym

Where are my classes located?

Anson Jones is divided into grade level hallways, a science wing, and two elective wings . 6th graders will have classes on the bottom floor. 7th and 8th graders will have classes on the second floor. Science classes are located on the bottom floor. A majority of our elective classes are located adjacent to the cafeteria.

What are the requirements of P.E.

All students are required to take P.E. during the school year. Students are required to dress out in the Anson Jones P.E. uniform. P.E. uniforms can be purchased during Orientation nights and during the first few weeks of school. Locker rooms are located in the main gym. 6th grade students will take an SFA class in lieu of P.E. for 9 weeks at some point in the school year. 7th graders will have a semester of Computer Literacy in lieu of P.E.

Does Anson Jones have an athletic program?

7th and 8th graders can participate in UIL athletic programs. Boys can participate in Football, Basketball, Track, Tennis and Golf. Girls can participate in Volleyball, Basketball, Track, Tennis and Golf. Students involved in athletic programs, can participate in an Athlet-

ics physical education class in lieu of P.E.

What are the school colors and mascot?

Anson Jones is home to the mighty Cougars. Our colors are Black and Gold. Students can show their Cougar pride by wearing Anson Jones spirit shirts on Friday with their uniform pants.

Does Anson Jones have an AVID program?

Yes! We are proud to be an AVID school. AVID stands for "Advancement Via Individual Determination". We believe every child can be eligible for college with the right support. Students with the eligible criteria can apply to be in an AVID class during their 7th and 8th grade year. All Anson Jones students will be supported with AVID strategies in the classroom. This includes learning organizational and study skills. Students will also be eligible to take AVID in High School.

What does it mean to be a "one binder campus"?

All students will be issued a black binder at the beginning of the school year. This binder is required for all classes. The binder will contain study guides and their school issued Agenda Book. This is meant to be a study guide and organizational tool for students and parents. Students are responsible for replacing their binder if it is lost or damaged.

How can I monitor my grades and attendance?

All students and parents are encouraged to set up an account with NISD's online Parent Connection. All you need is an email address. Grades and attendance are posted on this program. Triggers can be set up to notify you if your grades fall below a certain average.
