WHAT WE'RE LEARNING THIS WEEK: Letter Aa & Transportation

Language Arts/Literacy:

- **Letter of the week:** Letter Aa: identification, sound association. We will review the letters that have been introduced with activities that incorporate many letters and sounds.
- **Story Time:** This week we will look for our letter of the week in different words. We will also do a lot of prediction by previewing our books with a picture walk and predicting what will happen in the story.
- **Word of the week:** Transportation
- **Books We'll Be Reading This Week:** Bunnies On The Go by Rick Walton, I read Signs by Tana Hoban, Bunny Race! By Grace MacCarone, Curious George and the Hot Air Balloon by Margaret Rey and I'm Your Bus by Marilyn Singer
- **Ways you can help your child at home:**



Literacy: Read to your child at home daily and encourage them to retell the story or parts of the story to you during the story and after the reading. This practice will help reinforce comprehension of material read to them. :-)

Math:

- **Numbers:** This week we will continue with identifying and sequencing numbers and focus on numbers and their values. We will do number order activities and will reinforce number recognition with various activities during circle time.
- **Counting:** This week we will talk about different ways of counting including counting by 2's. We will practice counting by 10's to 100, as our 100th day is approaching!
- **Ways you can help your child at home:**
- Continue to work with your child to help them count to 30 without skipping any numbers. Most of the students are able to identify the numbers 0-10. Way to Go!
- Please help your child write his/her name using uppercase at the beginning and lowercase for the remaining. Some of our friends are forgetting that only the beginning letter is uppercase!
- Reinforce the letters and sounds that we've learned thus far: **Bb, Cc, Ee, Ff, Hh, Ll, Mm, Pp, Ss, Tt & Ww** and our new letter...**Aa!**
