Due to concerns based on information received from AACOG and the medical community regarding the ill effects that poor air quality can have on sensitive groups, NISD has enacted the following procedure for the safety of all students with asthma and/or pulmonary disease. Two options regarding outdoor activity will be recognized on Orange Air Quality Alert Days:

1. No Restrictions - students are released to go outside by a physician with no restrictions
2. Must Stay Indoors - no outdoor recess or athletic activity will be permitted
