Rules and Times

AM ISS starts at 7:45 AM and ends at 11:30 AM (end of third hour)

PM ISS begins at 2:22 (seventh hour) and ends at 6:15 PM

ALL DAY ISS starts at 7:45 AM or ends at 5:15 PM

Parents/Students are responsible for providing their own transportation.

The student will not be allowed back into mainstream classes until his/her ISS time has been served.

Failure to follow the stated rules will either result in extended ISS time or suspension from school.

- ❖ The student must be in his/her assigned seat in M102 before his/her ISS time begins. The student must sit up straight and face forward in his/her chair. To leave his/her seat, seek help, or speak the student must raise his/her hand and get permission. Putting one's head down or SLEEPING will result in extended time in ISS.
- ❖ If the student is tardy to AM ISS, report to M102 immediately. The student may be assigned to additional time for being late. If he/she is tardy to the PM ISS, report to a tardy station to receive your tardy slip, and then report immediately to ISS. If he/she arrives more than fifteen minutes late, he/she may be assigned further consequences.
- ❖ Bring ALL materials and ALL BOOKS for ALL classes each day.
- ❖ No eating, drinking, or chewing gum. No sunglasses. No portable music devices. No cell phones or pagers. No portable video games.
- ❖ The student may only work on school work. The student should get all work from the ISS teacher. All work will be checked off in his/her folder when he/she turns it in. Students must work.
- ❖ Absolutely no communication with anyone else unless instructed by the ISS teacher.
- ❖ Make certain that all papers turned in are checked off in his/her folder and that the teacher's name is on the top of the paper.
- ❖ All NISD rules as listed in the Student Handbook will be enforced.
