Night School –There are 4 sessions of Night School at each semester. See your counselor for a registration form. You can earn 1/2 credit for each session of night school. Night school grades will not average with day school grades.

Summer School – You must consider summer school if you fail a course this year or you are behind a credit in any of your academic courses. Do not expect to be able to take two of the same core courses on your Senior daytime schedule. (Example: You cannot take English 3 and English 4 during Sr. year to catch up.)

Dual Credit -Dual Credit Parent Night is scheduled in January at Northwest Vista College campus.

The **Accuplacer** exam is scheduled to be given on the O'Connor twice during the spring semester. Students can also call the testing center at NVC to schedule other times for administration. Anyone not testing at O'Connor must take the test at Northwest Vista. The cost is \$15.00 paid to Northwest Vista.

Credits - In order to be a Senior you must have at least 17 credits and all courses necessary for graduation must fit into your day schedule. Your earned credits must include:

3 credits in English

2 credits in Math

2 credits in Science and

2 credits in Social Studies
