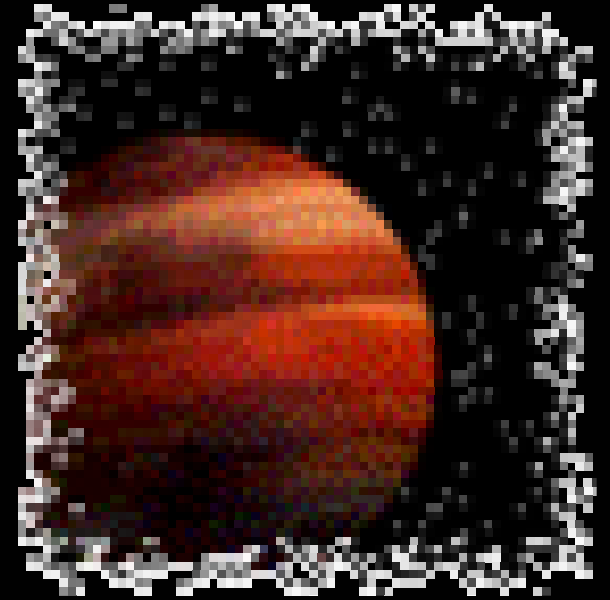
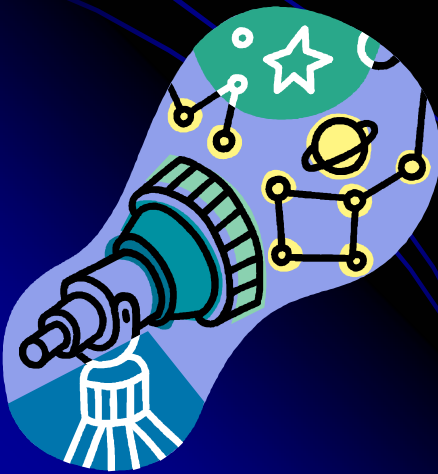

- The mass: $1,900e 27\text{kg}$



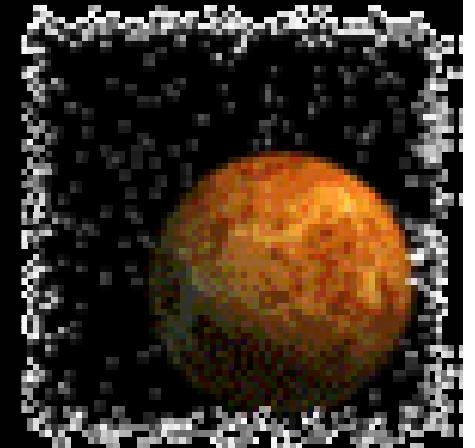
More Facts about Jupiter

- It also has lots more small ones that does not have a name.

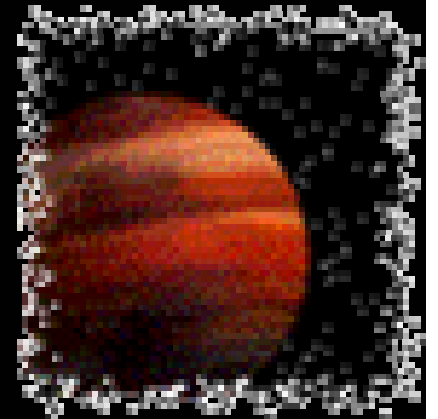


Other Facts About Jupiter

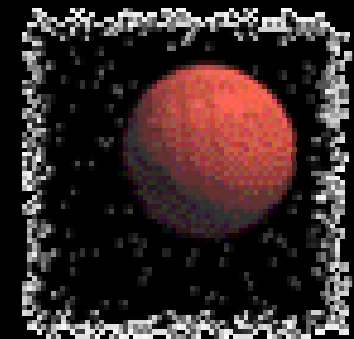
- The distance from the sun will be 483,800,000.

- Surface temp 166 degrees f



More Facts



- Jupiter has 28 moons all by itself
- If Jupiter was 80 times its size it will be a star
- Jupiter can take up to 1,300 times in space.
- If two Earth were put together it will be one size of Jupiter's moons





Other Facts

- Surface gravity is 2.36 times as Earth
- The core of Jupiter is made out of liquid rock
- Jupiter big red storm is twice as big as Earth
