## Kindergarten

### Reading/Writing Connections

- \* Make a sock puppet for the character the book/story was mostly about. Attach to the puppet the title of the book and the name of the author.
- \* Make a flip, shape or pop-up book showing the beginning, the middle, and the end of the story you read. On the front of the book, write the title of the book and the name of the author.
- \* Use play dough to create a character from the book you read and bring it in to share with your classmates. With the character, write a sign which gives the title of the book and the name of the author.
- \* If you could be one of the characters in this book, which character would you want to be? Why would you choose to be this character? Draw a picture of you as the character and bring it in for show-and-tell. On the picture, tell the title of the book and the name of the author.
- \* The setting of the story is where the story takes place. It can change in different parts of the story. Fold a piece of paper in three sections. Draw the setting at the beginning, the middle and the end of the story. Write the title of the book and the name of the author on the paper.

### Technology Connections

- \* Draw your favorite part of the story or your favorite character in the story using KidPix. Be sure to add a sentence about your story. Write the title of your book and the name of the author.
- \* After you have read the ABC book of your choice, use KidPix stamps with the first letter of your name to create an ABC page. Write the title of the book and the name of the author on the page.
