







TicTacToe Reading Guidelines

*Use the squares on the grid as a guideline for checking out books on Library Day (Thursday) or read books you have at home. Parents are welcome to check out books from the library also.

*To complete a square on the grid, your child must read the book, or have it read to him/her, and then complete a Connection Activity to the best of their ability. When they bring their Connection work in, the teacher will evaluate it to see if the work has been done to the student's best ability. Complete one row at a time until they "blackout!"
