Registration

Tuition - Fees - Refunds

A lab fee of \$10.00 will be assessed for all science classes.

Dress

A neat and well-groomed appearance is a requirement for registration and attendance. The NISD dress and grooming regulations are to be followed. For example, shorts, skorts, bagging/sagging pants and body piercing jewelry are not permitted.

Attendance

Regular and punctual attendance is mandatory. Students planning vacation trips at any time during the summer term should not enroll as there will be NO EXCUSED ABSENCES FOR SUCH TRIPS. The only excused absences are for personal illness or a death in the immediate family. An accumulation of 3 absences will place the student in a position of being dropped from classes. There will be no early dismissal at the end of the term. ATTENDANCE ON THE FINAL DAY OF CLASSES IS REQUIRED FOR COURSE CREDIT. Students who are tardy miss instruction time and cause a major disturbance. Three tardies will be counted as one unexcused absence.

Qualifications

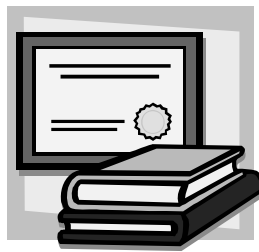
All students who register for Summer School must have the approval of their principal or counselor in order to certify that the program planned will meet their individual needs.

Transportation

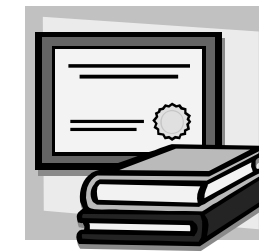
