- Registration will be on a First Come, First Served basis. No priority will be given to previous participants or students who have been on the waiting list.

- On the day of registration, parents or guardians should register their own children only (please do not pick up applications for a friend or neighbor.)
- Please bring the following information on the day of registration: Social Security Number, Student ID number, medical information, and current contact information including address and telephone numbers for parent/guardian, person to contact in case of emergency, and any other persons who can pick up your child.

The Learning Tree is an award-winning, quality program that is funded by a 21st Century Community Learning Centers grant from the Texas Education Agency and administered through the district's department of Adult and Community Education. This grant allows the program and its services to be offered free of charge to you and your family.

The program includes: daily USDA snack, Homework Help or Tutoring, Enrichment Classes, Community Service and Service Learning, Character Development and Team Building, Saturday Program at the Boys & Girls Club, and Monthly Parent University events.
