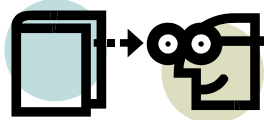


One-Word Response

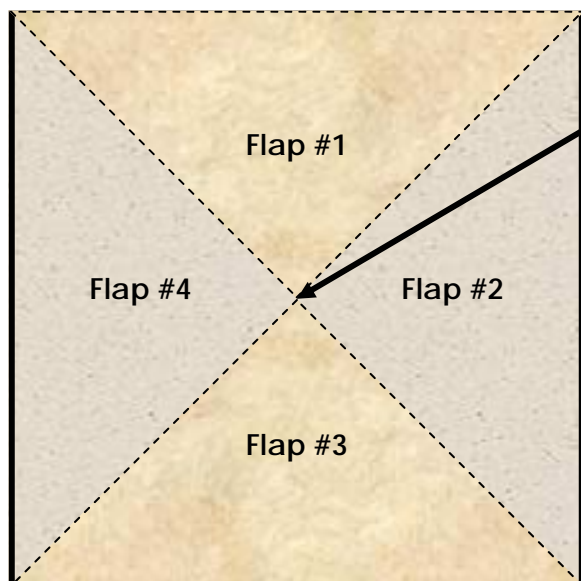

DIRECTIONS: Using an 8 ½" X 8 ½" piece of paper, fold the paper so that all four corners touch in the center; see sample below. Then, respond thoughtfully to each of the directives below.

- Flap #1:** Write one word or phrase to describe what the novel was about.
- Flap #2:** Write one sentence to describe how this word or phrase applies to the novel's protagonist.
- Flap #3:** Write one example of textual evidence from the novel that explains or illustrates the theme. **You must use a direct quotation and implement correct parenthetical documentation for the quotation.**
- Flap #4:** Draw an object that represents the novel. Include the title and author on this flap.
- Inside Center Square:** Write one fully-developed paragraph (5-7 sentences) explaining a connection between the novel AND **one** chapter in *How to Read Literature Like a Professor*.
