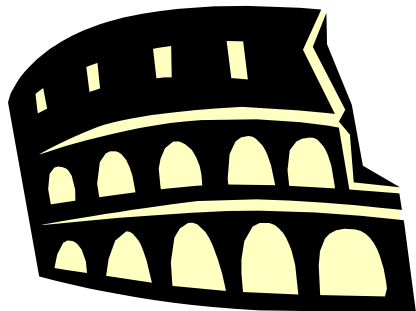
Population: 2,546,806

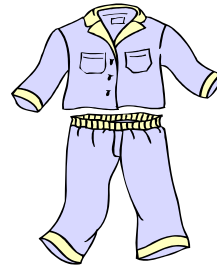
