

# **Connally Personal Electronic Device Policy**

## **Expectations**

### Campus Common Areas (Hallways, Cafeteria, Library, Restrooms, etc)

- Personal electronic devices can be used by students:
  - o Before 8:36am (first bell)
  - After 3:55pm (last bell)
- Personal electronic devices should not be used for:
  - o Taking pictures/videos on campus
  - o Posting or commenting on Social Media.
- During passing periods, personal devices, including earbuds (wired or wireless) must be put away.

#### **Locker Rooms**

Electronic devices are not allowed in the locker room or PE classes. Devices must be secured in assigned PE lockers.

#### Classrooms

Each teacher has a Red/Yellow/Green Stop Light posted in their classes. The teacher will use this to indicate to students the classroom expectations for technology use during the lesson.

- Red Technology is to be off (not on silent or vibrate)
- Yellow Ask first Technology should be face down on the corner of the desk.
- Green Use Students must stay on task while using technology.



### **Possible Consequences for Policy Violations**

- Device is picked up by teacher/staff and returned at the end of the class period.
- Device is picked up and turned into the office for student pick up at the end of the day.
- Device is picked up and turned into the office for parent pick up at the end of the day.
- Loss of personal device privileges on campus up to 5 days.

Consequences are issued based on factors such as: seriousness of the offense, student's age, frequency of the misconduct, the student's attitude, the potential effect of the misconduct on the school environment, and other pertinent factors as laid out in the NISD Student Code of Conduct C-12. \*Final determination of consequences rests with the Principal and his designees.
