Stadium Guidelines

1. There will be no decoration on the goal posts. Banners, signs, and replicas of school mascots, other than those used at the goal posts, shall be of a permanent nature and placed at fixed points. Banners, signs, and replicas of the school mascots are limited to student organizations and authorized booster organizations. Paper banners will not be allowed.
2. Presence on the field prior to and during the game, including half time, and after the game – apart from the players and those directly connected with the game – shall be limited to middle school administrators and four (4) student photographers.
3. Spectators will sit on the home side (west side)
4. Schools will not bring live animals into the stadium.
5. No victory lines will be permitted inside the outer perimeter of the track.
6. Handheld noisemakers that will be allowed are cowbells, thunder sticks and clappers.
7. All flags in grandstands shall be no larger than 12 inches by 18 inches. Any flags or banners larger than 12 inches by 18 inches shall be placed in fixed positions.
8. One-person hand-held signs in good taste not to obstruct the view of other fans.
9. Balloons will be prohibited.

10. Everyone must have a ticket to enter the stadium. School aged students (first grade and above) must have a ticket.
11. No outside food or drink items are allowed in the stadium. Concessions will be available for spectators to purchase food and drink.
12. Strollers are not allowed in the stands.
13. Tailgating not allowed on the premises.
14. In accordance with UIL policy, drones shall not be used in conjunction with any scrimmage or game.
15. Anyone who leaves the stadium will not be allowed to re-enter without purchasing another ticket.

Team Information

1. Both teams will be on the west side (Home Side) of the stadium. Home team will stand on the south side, Visitors will stand on the north side.
2. Westside locker room will be available for the home team, East Side locker room will be available for visiting team.
3. 8-minute quarters. 5 minute Halftime
4. Trainer, Ice and Water will be provided by the stadium.
5. Teams of the first game will exit the field immediately after the game and return to campus. If the winning team decides to stay and watch please notify the AO so we can make seating arrangements.

Bus Parking

1. Teams will park on the home side. Enter the stadium through the south gate.
