# Superintendent's Report

#### Dr. Brian Woods reported to the Board:

- House Public Education Testimony. Dr. Woods was invited to testify on HB 3 (86R) and HB 1525 (87R) before the Texas House of Representatives Public Education Committee.
- Back to School Events Begin. Several key district staff events will be taking place soon marking the beginning of the new school year. These include Leadership Institute, New Teacher Academy, and Convocations.
- **Summer Graduation.** The annual Summer Graduation event will take place Aug. 11 and will be held at the Paul Taylor Field House.
- Budget Finalization. There will be two called Board meetings in August for purposes of finalizing the District's budget.
- SA City Council Honors NISD. The District, along with a number of city Refugee Resettlement agencies and support organizations, was honored at a recent San Antonio City Council meeting and presented a proclamation naming June 20 as World Refugee Day. Victor Raga, Director of Bilingual Education, accepted the proclamation on behalf of NISD.
- **Video Moment.** Tonight's video moment featured some **Brandeis HS** students who turned a school community service project into a colorful and meaningful experience.
