

Northside ISD Athletic Complex Guidelines

(Farris Stadium, Gus Stadium, Grass Soccer Fields, Baseball & Softball Fields)

1. Buses must park in designated areas at each facility. Do not park in the fire lane.
2. Tailgating not allowed on the premises.
3. Everyone must have a ticket or a pass to enter the stadium. School aged students (first grade and above) must have a ticket. All tickets sold online at nisd.net/district/athletics.
4. Anyone who leaves the stadium will not be allowed to re-enter without purchasing another ticket.
5. No outside food or drink items are allowed in the stadium.
6. Strollers are not allowed in the stands.
7. Schools will not bring live animals into the stadium.
8. Handheld noisemakers that will be allowed are cowbells, thunder sticks and clappers.
9. Flags and hand-held signs in good taste not to obstruct the view of other fans.
10. Balloons will be prohibited.
11. Banners, signs, and replicas of school mascots, shall be of a permanent nature and placed at fixed points. Banners, signs, and replicas of the school mascots are limited to student organizations and authorized booster organizations. Paper banners will not be allowed.
12. Presence on the field prior to and during the game, including half time, and after the game – apart from the players and those directly connected with the game – shall be limited to high school students, cheerleaders, flag detail, bands of participating teams, those essential to support the break-through, and four (4) student photographers at football, soccer & track, and two (2) student photographers at baseball & softball.
13. In accordance with UIL policy, drones shall not be used in any game
14. District facilities will follow all policies and procedures set by NISD.
