

NORTHSIDE ISD - CREDIT-BY-EXAM 2025-2026

Credit-by-Exam (CBE) is a testing program offered by Northside ISD for currently enrolled students in Kindergarten and 1st through 12th grade. The purpose of CBE can be for acceleration (testing out of a grade level or course without having had any prior instruction), validation of home school or non-accredited private or public school credit when other methods are not available, and/or recovery of credit for a failed course.

NISD orders & proctors CBEs through [Texas Tech University K12](#) to evaluate a student's mastery of Texas standards for a given subject. Scoring of these exams are conducted through TTU K12 & may take up to 4 weeks to process. Scores are based on a numerical scale of 0-100 and no other information or feedback is provided by TTU K12 other than the numerical scores on the score report. Please visit their website for study guides & exam information. Students are allowed only two attempts per subject area & may take a specific exam only once during each testing window (Jan.1-March 31, April 1-June 30, July 1-Sept.30, Oct.1-Dec.31). All grade level acceleration will only occur at the beginning of the school year (mid-year and end-of-year acceleration is not allowed) and may only accelerate out of one entire grade level per year. Passing scores (80% or higher for acceleration; 70% or higher for validation or recovery) are maintained in the student record and, for high school level courses, these scores are posted to the student's transcript and are used in computing the student's High School Grade Point Average (HS GPA).
