PARENT AND FAMILY ENGAGEMENT POLICY 2025-2026

Northside ISD is committed to our mission and vision: Transform the learning experiences for students so that every day, every student can grow in confidence, curiosity, and capability. Northside strives to provide a high-quality education for all students by developing and maintaining supportive relationships with families and the community. One way to do this is by participating in the Title I, Part A Program. This program provides supplemental funding for low socioeconomic schools in the district. Each year, parents/guardians of Title I students and campus/district personnel jointly review the Title I, Part A program, along with the parent and family engagement policy, and discuss how Northside intends to use federal funds to support academic achievement at the Title I campuses. This parent and family engagement policy is then distributed to all parents/guardians of Title I students in English and Spanish, as well as posted on the district's website.

Northside ISD is committed to building mutually beneficial relationships between home and school by providing a strong family engagement program at all Title I campuses. The expectation of this program is to foster communication and decision-making with parents and to collaboratively support learning by providing opportunities for parents/guardians to become actively engaged.

- Encourage your child to put a high priority on education and utilize the educational opportunities that the campus provides such as enrichment programs, extra-curricular activities, and family night events.
- Monitor your child's academic progress through ongoing communication such as progress reports, report cards, scheduled conferences, and the school/parent/student compact.
- Participate in the campus decision-making process for school policies, instructional programs, funding, campus improvement plan implementation, and evaluation of the campus PFE policy and compact by serving as a member of the School Advisory Team (SAT) and/or the Parent and Family Engagement Committee (PFEC).
- Know the professional qualifications of the classroom teachers who instruct your child. Federal law allows you to ask certain information about teaching degrees, certifications, and licenses; and requires the campus to give this information to you in a timely manner.

To support parent and family engagement at Title I campuses, staff are trained on the most effective PFE strategies and in the value and utility of engaging parents in programs, partnerships, and building ties between school and home. The Northside's Family Engagement Program works with the Title I staff to ensure a strong, effective family program by providing coordination, technical assistance, and other support necessary to assist and build capacity of families and schools.
