M A T H	Statistics AP/DC (MATH 1442-Fall & Spring)	Students can take this course after Algebra II.	1	4
	College Algebra DC (MATH 1414-Fall & Spring)	Students can take this course after Algebra II.	1	4
	Pre-Cal DC (MATH 1414-Fall/2412-Spring)	Students can take this course any time after Algebra II. Students will earn college credit for College Algebra in the Fall and PreCal in the Spring.	1	8 total (4 per semester)
	Calculus AB AP/DC (MATH 2413-Fall & Spring)	Students can take this course ONLY if they have earned Dual Credit for PreCal DC or earned a 3+ on the AP PreCal Exam. Students will earn college credit for Calculus I.	1	4
	Calculus BC AP/DC (MATH 2413-Fall/2414-Spring)	Students can take this course ONLY if they have earned Dual Credit for PreCal PAP/DC. Students will earn college credit for Calculus I and II.	1	8 total (4 per semester)
