

Dual Credit Eligibility

Alamo Colleges classifies all dual credit students as either non degree-seeking or degree-seeking, and these two categories of students have different eligibility requirements.


Non Degree-Seeking

Students who have earned <u>15 or fewer</u> college credit hours, including those who wish to enroll in dual credit courses for the first time

Degree-Seeking

Students who have earned <u>more than 15</u> college credit hours and wish to continue taking dual credit courses

Non degree-seeking students who wish to enroll in an academic dual credit course must meet **ONE** of the following NISD-established criteria based on EOC scores, GPA, or other standardized exam scores as indicated below.



Degree-seeking students who wish to continue taking dual credit courses must demonstrate college readiness through **ONE** of the following measures:
