What is MAP Growth?

MAP Growth is an online, personalized assessment that adapts to your child's responses to measure their academic skill level for math and reading. Ultimately, MAP Growth assessments provide immediate and accurate information about your child's learning over time. Math and English Language Arts teachers will use results to tailor classroom lessons and set goals for students.

When will MAP Growth be administered?

MAP Growth will be administered according to the information provided below. The data from these assessments are a key tool for teachers to customize instruction for your child. Please make every effort to ensure they are in attendance on each assessment date.




