Attention Luna Parents:

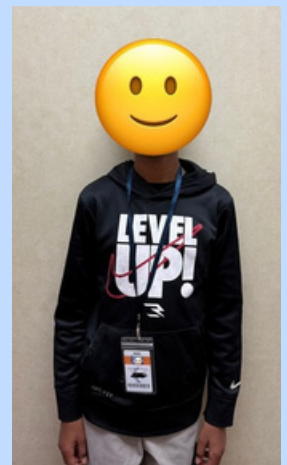
There's a new safety measure for our campus. We are now requiring students to display their campus issued school ID.
