



Northside Threads is a clothing closet that gives FREE gently used clothes to enrolled NISD students who need them.

OUR MISSION:

To remove attendance barriers by providing students with the clothing they need to feel confident and ready for school.

WHAT DO STUDENTS RECEIVE?

Each NISD student enrolled at a NISD school will be able to select:

- 5 gently used tops
- 5 gently used bottoms
- 5 brand new socks
- 5 brand new underwear

as supplies permit.

HOW TO GET ACCESS:

NISD students who need clothes can ask their school counselor for a referral to Northside Threads.

Parents of enrolled NISD students can also call their child's school and ask the counselor for a referral to Northside Threads.

A referral is required to get clothes.
