STINSON MAGNET: EXERCISE & HEALTH SCIENCE

Stinson Magnet Middle School offers a specialized program in Exercise Science and Sports Medicine that emphasizes hands-on learning and cross-content Project-Based Learning (PBL). Coursework is aligned with Exercise Science programs at NISD high school magnets and comprehensive campuses, ensuring a strong pathway from middle to high school.

The three-year program includes customized English Language Arts (ELA) and Science courses, along with Career and Technical Education (CTE) classes designed to immerse students in the field. Magnet students also have multiple opportunities to earn high school credit while still in middle school.

The program is housed on the Stinson Middle School campus using a school-within-a-school model. Magnet students take their ELA, Science, and CTE courses in dedicated classrooms and specialized spaces, including a physical therapy lab designed to foster collaboration and PBL experiences. The remainder of their schedule includes core courses with peers across the campus, as well as access to a wide range of electives and extracurricular activities, including athletics for 7th and 8th graders.
