NEW STATE LAW *Regarding Cell Phones*

DISCONNECT TO RECONNECT



At Northside ISD, we are committed to providing a safe, focused, and distraction-free learning environment for every student.

In compliance with **House Bill 1481**, all students must power off their cell phones and store all electronic devices—including phones, smartwatches, earbuds, tablets, and similar items—in their backpacks or in a designated classroom location.

This policy is in effect **from the first bell to the last bell**, including passing periods and lunchtime. Students in violation of this State law could be subject to disciplinary consequences.



Phone Law

All personal devices should be turned off and put away during the day.

“During the day” includes passing period and lunch.

There is no charge for confiscated phones.

Campus Security

NEVER open exterior doors to let someone in, and NEVER prop doors open. Only the staff is authorized to take care of any visitors.

Entry through front office and bus loop entrances only before 9 AM. During dismissal, exit only through front office doors.
