APPLICATION INFO

- To be eligible, students must be accepted and planning to attend one of the Alamo Colleges at least half-time (6 or more hours per semester).
- Scholarship eligibility is based on various factors, including academic merit, program of study, service, activities, and/or financial need. Foundation scholarships are awarded and administered without regard to race, sex, color, ethnicity, or national origin. All students are invited to apply.
- Merit and need-based opportunities are available. Students who wish to compete for need-based scholarships must submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at studentaid.gov or the Texas Application for State Aid (TASFA) to qualify.

2026-2027 OFF-CAMPUS LUNCH UPDATE

In partnering with parents, the district is updating the off-campus lunch guidelines for juniors and seniors to support student safety, responsibility, and academic success. These guidelines establish clear expectations to help students qualify and maintain their off-campus lunch privileges.

NEW GUIDELINES BEGINNING THE 2026-2027 SCHOOL YEAR:

- 1 Students must have written parent permission;
- 2 Students must be passing all classes at semester;
- 3 Students must not have more than 9 absences at semester in a class;

NEW STATE LAW *Regarding Cell Phones*

DISCONNECT TO RECONNECT



At Northside ISD, we are committed to providing a safe, focused, and distraction-free learning environment for every student.

In compliance with **House Bill 1481**, all students must power off their cell phones and store all electronic devices—including phones, smartwatches, earbuds, tablets, and similar items—in their backpacks or in a designated classroom location.

This policy is in effect **from the first bell to the last bell**, including passing periods and lunchtime. Students in violation of this State law could be subject to disciplinary consequences.



Phone Law

All personal devices should be turned off and put away during the day.


“During the day” includes passing period and lunch.
