What is College, Career, and Military Readiness (CCMR)?

A measure that schools use to determine if a student is prepared for post-secondary opportunities including college, career, or the military. Students earn a CCMR Point in HS based on the indicators below.

A student is College Ready by meeting criteria through testing OR courses.

Testing: Meet criteria for both Reading *and* Math in one or more of the college readiness indicators below:

A student is Military Ready by meeting criteria through JROTC or enlisting after graduation.

JROTC Completion PLUS ASVAB

- ☐ Complete 4 years of JROTC **AND** achieve a passing score on the ASVAB test. *(Class of 2027 and after only.)*

Enlistment

- ☐ Graduate and enlist in the Texas National Guard, any of the 6 services in the Armed Forces, or the National Guard for the respective service.

A graduate receiving Special Education Services achieves CCMR by meeting any of the indicators above or through one of the two pathways indicated below:

Advanced Degree Plan

- ☐ Graduate receiving Special Education Services and earn the Foundation High School Plan **WITH** an Endorsement.

IEP and Workforce Ready

- ☐ Graduate with a completed IEP **AND** demonstrate Workforce Readiness.
