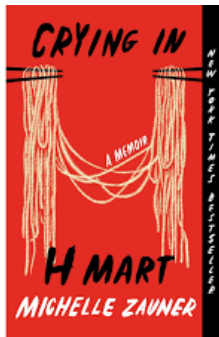

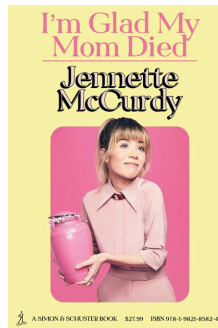
Welcome to English 4 Honors Dual Credit Required Summer Reading

This summer, choose ONE of the memoirs below to read. Be prepared to have read your memoir by the first day of class.

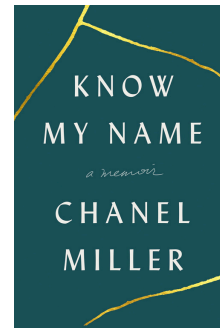
