SB 12 VENDOR NOTIFICATION

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF POLICY & STATUTORY APPLICABILITY

By executing this document, the Vendor acknowledges receipt of (or accessible electronic access to) Northside ISD Board Policies and agrees that all owners, employees, contractors, and agents performing work on behalf of the District shall comply with Texas Education Code (TEC) § 11.005, TEC § 28.0022, and District Policies BT, CJ, and EMB.

PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES

1. DEI Duties (TEC § 11.005 & Policy BT): Except as strictly required by state or federal law, Vendor personnel shall not intentionally or knowingly perform, engage in, or assign any person to perform Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) duties for or on behalf of the District.
2. Prohibited Instruction & Programming (TEC § 28.0022 & Policy EMB): Vendor personnel shall not intentionally or knowingly provide, or assign another person to provide, instruction, guidance, activities, or programming prohibited by state law or Board Policy.
3. Sexual Misconduct / Employment Assistance (TEC § 21.0581 & Policy CJ): Vendor shall not assist any person in obtaining employment if the Vendor knows, or has probable cause to believe, that the individual engaged in unlawful sexual misconduct involving a minor or student (subject to routine file transmissions under CJ(LEGAL)).

LIMITATIONS AND PERMITTED CONDUCT

This summary does not supersede state/federal law or Board Policy. Conduct required by federal or state law, court order, or lawful District direction is permitted. If the application of any policy requirement is uncertain, the Vendor must request written guidance from the District Purchasing Department prior to proceeding.

BREACH, DISCIPLINE AND APPEALS

1. Immediate Termination: A determination by the District that the Vendor intentionally or knowingly violated TEC § 11.005 or § 28.0022 constitutes a material breach of contract, resulting in immediate contract termination and PO cancellation without penalty to the District.
2. Due Process & Appeals: The Vendor will receive written notice and an opportunity to respond. Final disciplinary actions may be appealed pursuant to Board Policy GF(LOCAL) within twenty (20) calendar days of notification.
