

CLARK HIGH SCHOOL SPRING 2022

If You Test Positive for COVID-19 (Isolate) OR you start having COVID-19-like symptoms

- If you **test positive**: everyone, regardless of vaccination status or presence of symptoms.
- If you start having **COVID-19 like symptoms**: regardless of vaccination status

- Stay home for 5 days.
- Fill out the Clark HS [COVID Form](#)
- You can return to school after the 5 days
If you are free of fever for at least 24 hours without the help of medication AND you have no symptoms or your symptoms are resolving.
- Continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days.

If you have a fever or symptoms and have not improved, continue to stay home for up to 10 days, until your fever resolves, and symptoms improve. Contact the attendance office if your student will be absent beyond the 5 initial days.

If You Were Exposed to Someone with COVID-19 (Quarantine) AND do not have any symptoms

And are under 18 years old:

- And Completed the primary series of the Pfizer, Moderna, or J&J vaccines

And are over 18 years old:

- Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine within the last 6 months

OR

- Completed the primary series of J&J vaccine within the last 2 months

OR

- Have received a booster

- You are able to come back to school
- You should wear a mask around others for 10 days.

If you develop symptoms, fill out the Clark HS [COVID form](#) to notify the nurse, get a test (on day 5 if possible) and stay home.
