
Opening in Fall 2026, Stinson Middle School will welcome it's inaugural class of 6th grade students to Northside ISD's newest magnet program.

Elective options for Rising Dual Language students who have been accepted into the Stinson Magnet Program Option 1 Student opts for Adv Spanish 2 - the student could then take Advanced Spanish 3 in 7th and Spanish 4AP in 8th. However, in this scenario, to meet the state Fine Arts requirement, the only option is to take Dance PE in either 7th or 8th grade. If the student does not take Dance PE to fulfill the state Fine Arts requirement, a Fine Arts course must be taken in 8th grade - Spanish 4AP will not be an option. Or	requirement OR must take a F	Spanish AAP h or 8th grade to meet the Fine Arts Fine Arts elective in 8th instead
Option 2 Student opts for Fine Arts (to meet the state Fine Arts requirement) - the student may take Spanish the following year as a 7th grader. The Spanish Proficiency Assessment will be utilized for placement into the correct Spanish course in 7th grade. This would occur as part of the routine placement process for the campus since, by declining Advanced Spanish 2 in 6th grade, the student is no longer participating in the Advanced Spanish Program. Frequently Asked Questions

Can I participate in sports?

Yes! Magnet school students can join the same sports teams as their peers on their host campus. Team sports are open to 7th and 8th graders, and 6th graders can participate in extracurricular activities including intramural sports.

• What electives can I choose?

Students in the magnet school programs will take a CTE Magnet course in place of 6th grade advisory. In 6th grade, students will take a fine arts elective. In 7th and 8th grade, students have access to most of the same electives as their host campus peers. The middle school course catalog contains a complete list of the electives available to magnet students.

Is transportation available?

O Bus transportation is available to qualifying students. Buses typically pick up and drop off at selected Northside campuses <u>near the zoned middle school</u>.

What is the dress code?

 The magnet school campuses follow the standard Northside dress code that applies to all secondary schools in the district.

Who can apply?

 Applications are open to all San Antonio area 5th graders who exhibit a history of good behavior and regular attendance.
