PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

The Credit Advancement Summer Program provides current High School and rising 9th grade students with an opportunity to accelerate a High School credit through online platforms. The program is tuition-based and will be conducted via a hybrid learning environment (virtual and in-person). Credit Advancement is a supplemental program apart from the regular instructional school year. Summer CADV students should have the ability to independently navigate a rigorous online course curriculum and self-advocate when needing academic assistance.

TUITION: \$150 per 1/2 credit course
