The primary goal of morning meetings is to give students a safe environment that provides a sense of trust, allows students to feel important, and helps students separate from home and prepares the students for the day's events.

Intervention/Enrichment/ English Language Development







Independent practice for some students and live, small group with the teacher. IEP Instructional and Related Services are encouraged to be provided during this time. During Synchronous and Asynchronous learning, English Language Development (ELD), instruction, and intervention using Linguistic Instructional Accommodations will take place for English Learners.

Teacher Office Hours

Teachers will be available to students and families for direct instruction, instructional support and intervention/enrichment. Families can also schedule parent-teacher conferences to address student's academic progress.
