September flew by so quickly! It's hard to believe that we've been in school for six weeks and October has arrived. As you know, the district has had a tiered process to bring students back on campus; slowly and safely according to the city's health metrics. The groups currently on campus are: ALE, our Early Childhood Learners through 2nd grade and our Academically At-Risk students in grades 3rd-5th. On October 5th we are hoping to bring back the remaining students in grades 3-5 that chose "in person" learning on the August survey. Parents now have the opportunity to change their child's "learning location" for the second grading period by completing a survey by Sept. 30th. The hope is that these children could be on campus as early as October 19th. However, please understand this may not be the case for everyone depending on the metrics at that time. We are currently capped at 10 students per classroom. Until this class size limit is raised, we have several classrooms that cannot accommodate additional students. Campus administrators have not been given any information other than what I'm sharing here. When I receive additional information from the district I will send it out through a School Messenger. Until then we appreciate your patience and understanding. All of the Krueger teachers are working hard to navigate teaching both in-person and virtually. It is challenging work, but the staff is doing a great job! I am very proud to work with such dedicated educators and to serve as principal at Krueger Elementary!
