College Board Advanced Placement tests Opportunity for Home School Students

Home school students living in Northside ISD attendance boundaries are eligible to take the College Board Advanced Placement (AP) tests to be administered at the Northside ISD Student Services Building or a designated campus.

Students wishing to participate must provide:

- the AP home-school code from AP Services (call 888-225-5427 by March 1, 2017)
- the completed registration form
- proof of residence in Northside ISD (such as a utility bill showing parent name and residence address)
- AP test cost of \$93 per test (check or money order)
- photo ID for student (preferably government issued license or ID)

The completed registration and fee is due by March 3, 2017 to the Northside high school campus. The registration must include the appropriate fee for each test.
