

Northside ISD Transition to In-Person Learning

NISD will begin providing some in-person instruction beginning on Sept. 8 after Labor Day for those who selected this option. We will be using a methodical and tiered approach to bringing students safely back into schools.

The plan will allow for students who are most academically in-need to return first, and in small numbers, if their survey selection was in-person learning.

There is no anticipated timeline or schedule for when groups will be allowed to return to in-person instruction as it is dependent on health conditions. However, NISD will monitor conditions on a regular basis and decisions on which students will be brought back for in-person instruction will be communicated to families. As a general guideline, families will have a two-week notice for when their child may return.
