Sunday 2:00 PM - 6:00 PM (All Levels)


Students will be able to access the link on HAC under the school links tab, and in the students NISD portal with an icon that signifies Student Homework Support.

Morning Drop Off:

Thank you for having your screener ready to show the staff on duty! If you are coming from the Lockhill Selma side you may want to drop off using the Clark entrance in the mornings to avoid any additional delays. We have drop off in the front and on the side every morning. Please remember if you are after 7:45am, you will need to walk your child to the foyer and show your screener to the front office staff before your child will be able to enter the building. **The screener link is [here](#).**

Afternoon Pick Up:

Please form one line outside the school gate and once inside the gate you may split into two lanes. Creating two lanes outside the gate blocks others from exiting and emergency vehicles from gaining access if needed. The Drive Through behind the school is the only pick up option in the afternoons. We no longer have park and pick up or walk ups due to COVID 19. Please drive around the back of the school and our staff will assist you in where to go. See map for details. The 'NOT PERMITTED' section shows images of people wearing masks that are not under the nose, neck sleeves/gaiters, masks with exhalation valves, mesh face coverings, and face shields without masks.

PERMITTED

Face coverings **should**—

- Completely cover nose and mouth
- Fit snugly but comfortably against the side of the face
- Be secured with ties or ear loops
- Include multiple layers of fabric
- Allow for breathing without restriction
- Be laundered and machine dried without damage or change to shape
- Be pulled so that the bottom part of the mask is below the chin.

A face shield can be worn over a mask to provide additional eye protection.

Neck sleeves/gaiters, bandanas or scarves are permitted for **outdoor use only**.

NOT PERMITTED

Face coverings **should not** be worn under the nose, around the neck or forehead.

Neck sleeves/gaiters, bandanas or scarves are **not permitted for indoor use** as studies have shown them as less effective than other types of face masks.

Face coverings **should not** have an exhalation valve; although the valve allows you to exhale, it expels germs into the air and doesn't protect others.

Face coverings **should not** be made of mesh material; mesh does not cover the mouth and nose.

A face shield without a mask **does not** provide adequate protection.
