Thank you for your support during the month of January! We ask our Evers families to continue to reinforce the importance of reading with your child and review the skills assigned by your child's teacher when homework is given.

PRIORITY REGISTRATION for 2020-2021

If you have not completed your child's registration for the next school year, please complete as soon as possible. This allows our school to plan for the appropriate number of staff needed for each grade level and to secure a spot for your child. Contact our front office for any support at 210-397-2550.

PARENT PICK UP REMINDERS

Starting Monday, February 10, 2020 we will ask that parents picking up their child during dismissal come to the location of their child's teacher so that students do not walk alone through the crosswalk. Please do not wave students from the parent parking lot so that they can cross on their own. This becomes a student safety concern. We thank you for your support.

ARRIVAL

Please continue to work on dropping your child off by 7:40 am (Our first bell). A child is considered tardy if he/she is not in the classroom at 7:45 a.m. ***You will have 3 days to submit a parent/doctor's note or the absence will be considered unexcused. ***Only 4 written parent notes for each semester will be accepted.

DISMISSAL

Dismissal times are staggered for our grade level (PK-2:45 pm, 1st-2nd-2:50 pm & 3rd-5th 2:55 pm). Please send a note to your child's teacher if dismissal routine will change. Change of transportation at the end of the school day must be done before 2:15 p.m. to ensure the student goes home the right way. Dismissal is a busy time at our school. We appreciate your support!

LUNCHES

Please limit lunch deliveries through Uber Eats or any other food delivery apps. Our Evers Administration team will continue to monitor the impact it is having when our staff is having to deliver lunches to our students once food deliveries arrive to the school or the disruption that takes place during instructional time when paging kids to pick up their lunch in the front office. We highly recommend that parents have their child eat in our Evers cafe or pack a lunch from home and place in your child's backpack. Please assist us in not purchasing or bringing lunch for other students other than your own. Sharing food with other students is not allowed.

LUNCH VISITORS

Having lunch with your child is allowed, however, lunchtime is an opportunity for your child to socialize with other students and build resiliency skills. As much as possible, please allow your child to eat with their peers. Parents are asked to sit at the designated parent/student table on the stage. Please do not interact or talk to any other students during lunch, before or after school. For any questions, please contact our front office team.
